Definition

Video modeling is a form of observational learning in which the desired behaviors are learned by watching a video demonstration then imitating the behavior model.

- Video self-modeling
- Video priming
- Video modeling

Benefits of visual-based intervention

- Increased ability to gain and hold learners attention
- Consistency of training implementation
- Repeatability for mastery of skills
- Lower hierarchy level of prompting
- Strong visuals use primary learning modality for students with ASD
- Opportunities to share instruction with others
- Allows mastery of sequence of actions/behaviors without individual skill training

Advance Preparation and Tips

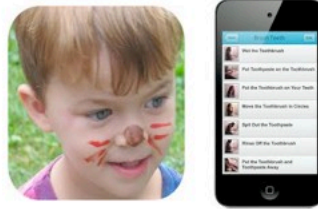
- iPad, iPhone or other camera with video option

- Photo release or consent
- Video assistant
- Clip length - 30 seconds or less
- Rehearse
- Take videos in the app to save time and effort



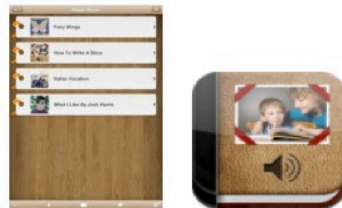
